NOTES FROM THE PRINCIPAL

It is that time of year again. How much will it cost us for 2012-2013? This is not an easy issue to address.

The Board of Education has grappled with the questions of what it will cost to offer a quality Christian education next year: personnel, curriculum and materials, insurance, maintenance, and other expenses. How can we continue to meet the school's financial commitments while still being as affordable as possible?

The numbers are attached to this newsletter. *We have made several changes.* Note that we have only ONE fee now that is due upon application for re-enrollment. We have combined the old "Registration Fee" and the "Comprehensive Fee" and have decreased that total. All other fees are now included in the tuition amount. (The one exception is that our Gr.6-8 Band students will have a \$60 band fee payable August 1.)

We have also adjusted our tuition rates. Following the lead of the other private schools on Maui and Oahu, we will have 3 payment plan options available including incentive rewards.

Financial Aid applications for 2012-2013 can be submitted to FACTS now. The first grants will be announced April 16.

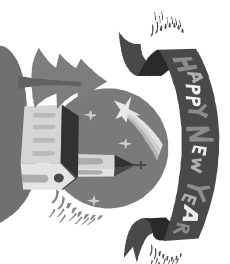

Fitness Fest Volunteers 2012

Aloha Parents,

Our annual Fitness Fest is going to be held on January 20th, which is a Friday. It will be at the Maui High track and field this year. For our Fitness Fest to run smoothly and efficiently, we need volunteers who are willing to help set up, during the event, and after the event. If you are able to help in any way it would be greatly appreciated.

Here is the breakdown of who we need at each station. Please email me at kumuboy8@hotmail.com, or come to my classroom to let me know where you are willing and able to work. If you want to volunteer for an event, but do not know how the event runs, I have instructions on how each event works.

Set Up 7:15am – 8:30am

We need help setting up all of the cones, tents (2 pop up) for water stations, hurdles (pvc pipes), signs for each event, and for the water stations setting up granola bars and cups of water.

Fitness Fest individual events 8:30am – 11:30am

100 Meter Dash – We need one person (1st volunteer) to use the stop watches to time the runners. (2nd volunteer) to be at the starting line to help students. Both volunteers are able to switch during the day.

100 Meter Hurdles – We need (1st volunteer) to use stop watches to time runners. (2nd volunteer) to be at the starting line to help students. (3rd volunteer) to pick up hurdles that fall.

Shuttle Run – We need (1st volunteer) to time one student, and (2nd volunteer) to time the second student. Two students run at the same time.

Standing Long Jump – We need (1st volunteer) to measure students' jump, with a measuring stick. We need (2nd volunteer) to help 1st volunteer.

Long Jump – We need (1st volunteer) to tell students how to run in the sandpit. The (2nd volunteer) and (3rd volunteer) will measure the jump with a tape measure, and will rake sand.

Football Toss – We need 4 volunteers to measure football tosses and to retrieve footballs that are thrown.

Field Goal Kick – We need 2 volunteers to place footballs on the football tee and to receive footballs from students who are retrieving kicks from classmates.

Water Stations – We need 4 volunteers to sit under popup tents, 2 at each tent station, to hand out water cups and granola bars to students.
